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Accreditation



- **Private voluntary accreditation provides the opportunity for an educational institution to attain standards above the minimum requirements**

Accreditation



- A planned systematic review process –
- by an institution, organization or program to determine whether national standards are being met, maintained and enhanced

Accreditation



- **Process – continuous upgrading**
- **Concept – self regulation**
- **Status - granted to an institution**

Areas for Evaluation



- Purposes and objectives – vision, mission, goals
- Faculty – qualifications and experience
- Instruction – curriculum, delivery, classroom management, assessment, supervision, support to instruction
- Library - print and non-print
- Laboratory --science, math, speech

Areas for Evaluation



- Physical plant – campus, building, maintenance, safety, adequacy
- Student services - extra curricular, guidance, canteen, health services, etc.
- Administration – school governance – organization structure, qualifications, performance, records mgt., planning and development
- School & community – partnership that impacts on performance

Kinds of Accreditation visits



- Preliminary survey
- Formal survey
- Re-survey
