


P: These are people who we look up to, people who we idealize, people we would want to be in our own fields someday

: Whenever you think about life after high school, you think of these problems or questions: What do I study or take up and where do I go? Financially, how do I pay for my schooling? What is my career path?




P: Edukasyon.ph is an online resource center that you can use to help you answer all those questions to give you the right opportunities to be empowered and eventually, successful.


