

- 1 Identifies a problem
- 2. Gathers information to solve a problem
- 3. Proposes multiple solutions to the problem
- 4. Compromises to arrive at a solution
- 5. Tests out solutions
- 6 Shows a willingness to adjust and improve the design after testing and feedback
- 7. Reflects and evaluates the design at the conclusion of the project



- 1 Generates original ideas (invention) or improves upon something (innovation)
- 2. Uses strategies to narrow the list of ideas
- 3. Demonstrates persistence and grit
- 4. Willing to try new things
- 5. Doesn't fear making mistakes
- 6. Seaks appropriate modes, materials, and resources to produce work that is visually appealing and interesting



- 1. Uses personal voice in writing
- 2 Explains thinking with words, graphs, charts, maps, diagrams, and images
- 3. Matches the purpose for communication with the intended audience
- 4. Shows reflection and growth through word choice



Collaboration

- Organizes and gathers team materials
- 2. Suggests new ideas
- 3. Asks questions to the group and teacher
- 4. Willing to lead and follow as a group member
- 5. Encourages members of the group
- 6. Shares and reports progress to the teacher and class
- 7. Helps to keep the group on task and working to meet goals and deadlines
- 8. Solves problems and works to resolve conflict within the group or with the project
- 9. Gleans up the workspace and returns materials



Communication (Oral Language)

- 1. Utilizes clear and articulate speech
- 2. Speaks in a confident voice
- 3. Uses appropriate volume
- Asks questions to clarify unknown topics
- 5. Provides expression and enthusiasm
